Dear Good-Hearted Donor,

Canadian Tamil Aid is a fund established by TCCT for the sole purpose of helping the Tamils living in the Northern and Eastern parts of Sri Lanka. TCCT was established in 1989 and is registered as a charitable organization in the province of Ontario. TCCT established Canadian Tamil Aid (CTA) as a sub-wing in 2003 to help the tsunami victims and later continued to function with the view of helping the less fortunate among Canadian Tamils and also the less fortunate people who lost all their possession and displaced from their homes in Sri-Lanka and elsewhere around the world.

Focussing on the displaced people in North and East of Sri-Lanka CTA has identified the following projects to alleviate the suffering the less fortunate in these region which was affected by three years of civil war. This project is undertaken with the support of Sunflowers Furniture Management:

1. Critical Medical & Healthcare Needs - 'VAIGARAI' Project under the Good Shepherd of Vavuniya District:
Adolescent girls who were taken into custody during the civil war were handed over to the Good Shepherd nuns for rehabilitation. They're in dire need to uplift and empower their life. Began a "Skill Training" and Income Generative Program" for them with an idea of providing employable skills and employment. The program aims at their secure future. At present there are 65 young girls; 30 for Skill Training, 9 for Education and 26 for Income Generative Programs.
2. Children's Welfare & Rehabilitation - 500 Children in Vaddakachchi at St. Joseph's Parish:
Activities include Disease & Disorder Awareness, Surgeries & Treatment, Counselling, Equipments and Facilities, Clinical training and Medical Research. The condition may be congenital, developmental, or acquired through disease, trauma, environmental cause or by the prolonged war for more than three decades.
3. English Language Education for Youth/Adults - Under the supervision of HUDEC (Caritas Kilinochchi):
Due to lack of suitable trained teachers, these children in Vanni are greatly disadvantaged compared to the rest of the island.

At present we envisage raising funds up to \$100,000 for the above critical needs of Vanni. Please find additional details about sponsorship for the above worthy cause in the attached sheet. We have arranged a Gala Event to be held on December 07, 2014 at Scarborough Convention Centre.

We thank you for your benevolent support in the past for our efforts. It is our fervent hope that you will kindly support us in the above worthy effort too. The conditions in Vanni are appalling and needs our support. You may visit Vanni.ca to learn more about this campaign initiative.
